Optimist Notes

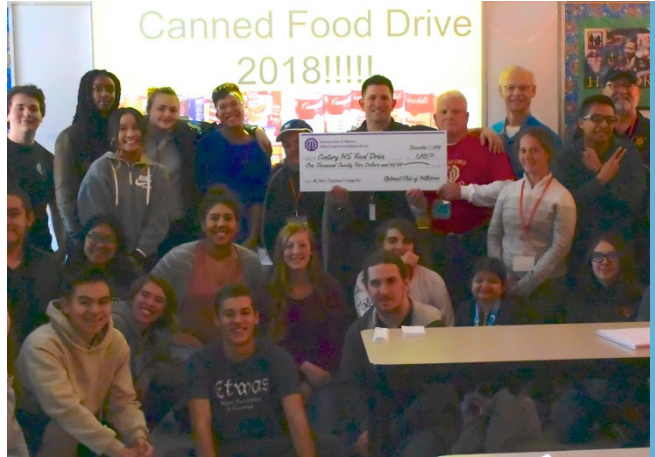
Monte Akers, Bill French, and Jack Thornton are working to develop essay contests in local high schools that feed into the Optimist regional contest. See them if you are interested in helping.

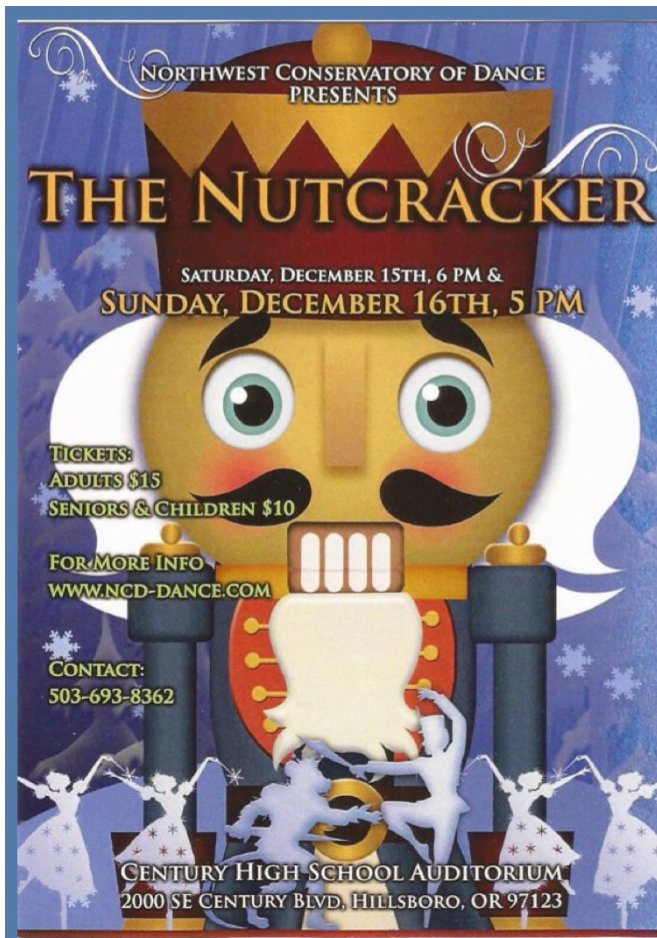
Optimists Help With Food Drive
