### Mathews Scholarship

The Optimist Club of Hillsboro offers this scholarship to a graduating senior. It is a \$1000 award. The award is paid toward tuition at a two or four year institution.

The candidate must:

- Be a graduating Hillsboro School District senior (or home schooled graduate who lives in the attendance area).
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Be US citizen or permanent legal resident.
- Have been accepted to a 2 or 4 year accredited school the US with a major in human health or mortuary science.
- Submit the required application and essay by May 5/11.
- Be available to be interviewed by the Optimist selection board.

The award is announced at the student's high school award assembly. The dollars will be mailed to the registrar of the selected 2/4 year institution at the start of student's freshman year.

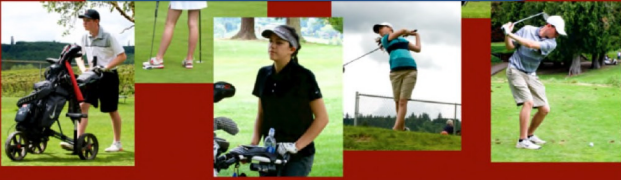
